



MAGIC CIRCLES

German designer Elisa Strozyk has an original way with materials – first she wowed us with her flexible wooden textiles that can be moulded into multiple shapes (including a lampshade, see right) and now she's rethinking another medium with her 'Ceramic Tables'. The tops are crafted using layers of liquid glazes – made by mixing metal oxides with powdered minerals – which are applied to a circular clay base. The circles are then rotated and air is blown across them to create unique swirling patterns. The sleek metal frame is available in either copper or steel.
